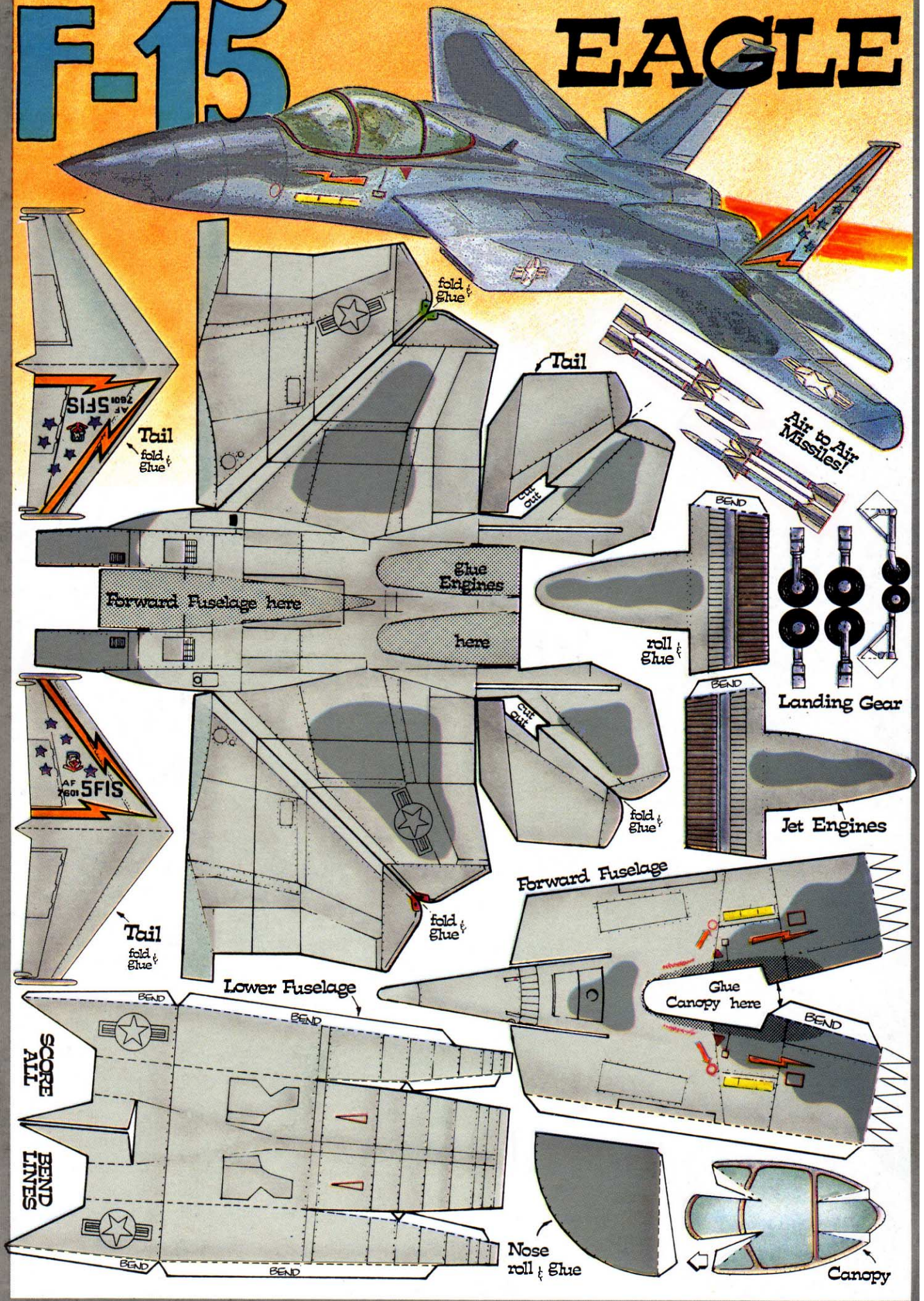
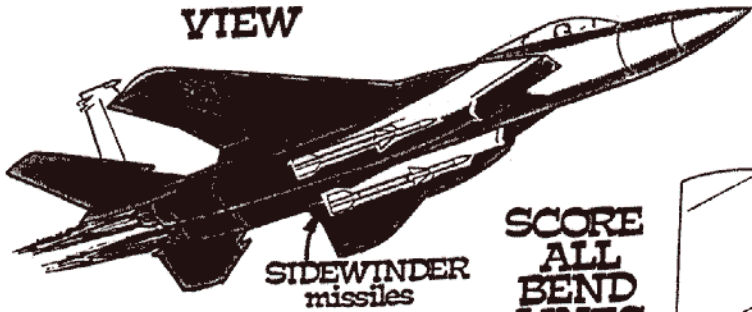

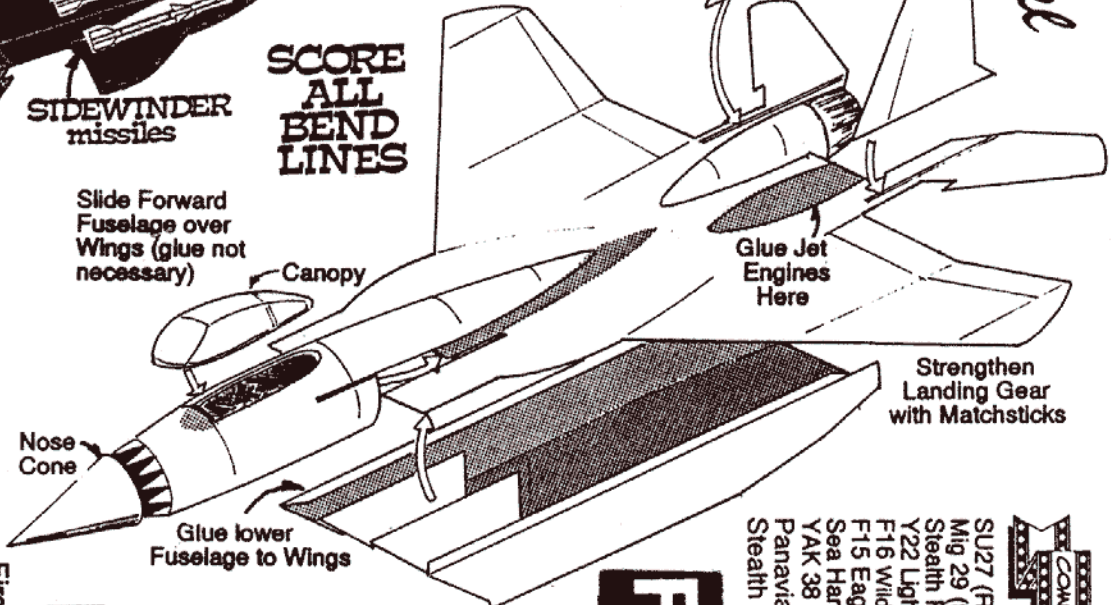
BOTTOM VIEW

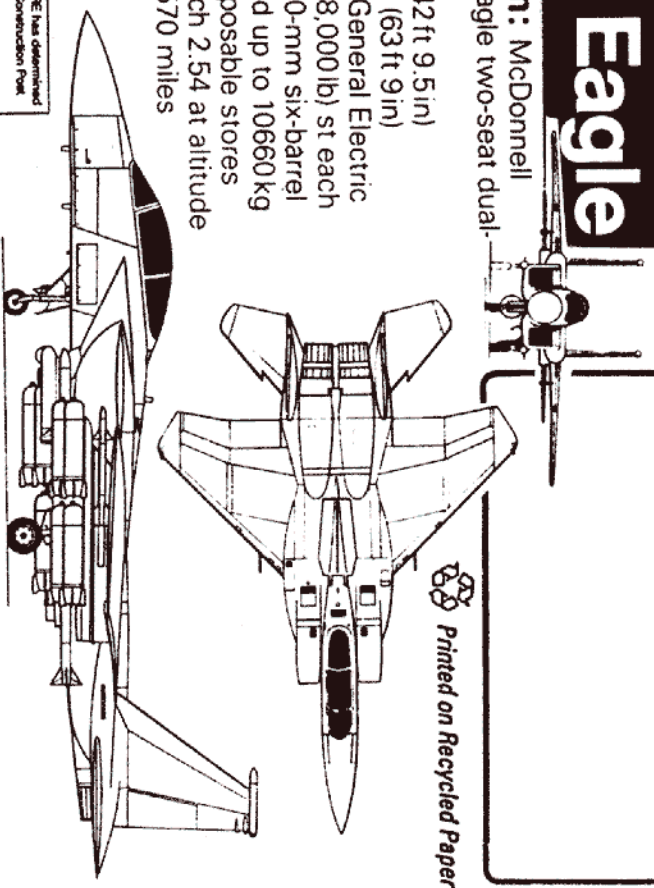

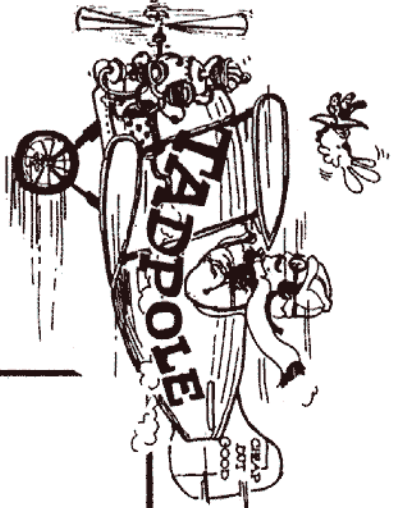

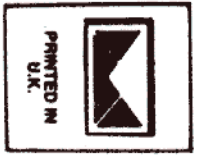

First flown in 1972, the F-15 multi-role fighter established itself as one of the best aircraft in its class in the world, with outstanding performance, manoeuvrability and load-carrying ability. The F-15A and B single- and two seat aircraft (respectively) were superseded by the improved F-15C and D in early 1980's introducing FAST packs for additional fuel, avionics and cameras. Currently entering USAF service (with orders for 392 aircraft) is the strengthened F-15E long-range adverse-weather dual-role fighter, employing new high resolution APG-70 radar plus FLIR and LANTIRN pods. F-15s have entered service with Israel, Saudi and Japanese air forces, and a STOL version in under development.
